

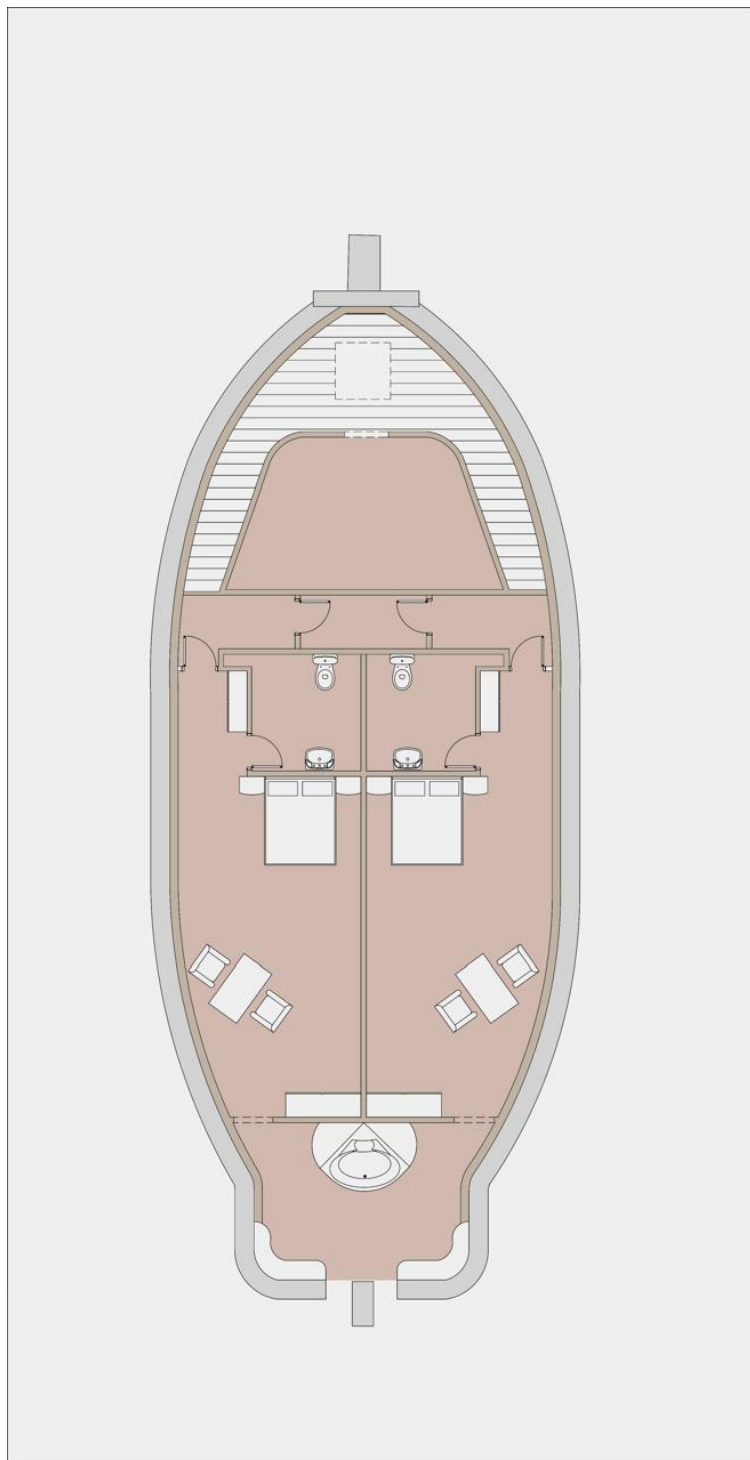


Deck Plans

CONVERTIBLE LAYOUTS & SHAPESHIFTING INTERIORS

Atoll Villa is a fully convertible-room yacht. Beds strike down into salons, salons open into cinemas, and the lower deck turns from cabins into dive and expedition stores. This document shows every published configuration across both decks, with photography of the conversions in progress.

Two Suites



The everyday arrangement: two full double suites amidships, each with its own bathroom, opening onto a shared aft lounge with loose seating that can be drawn together or pushed apart.

2 DOUBLE SUITES

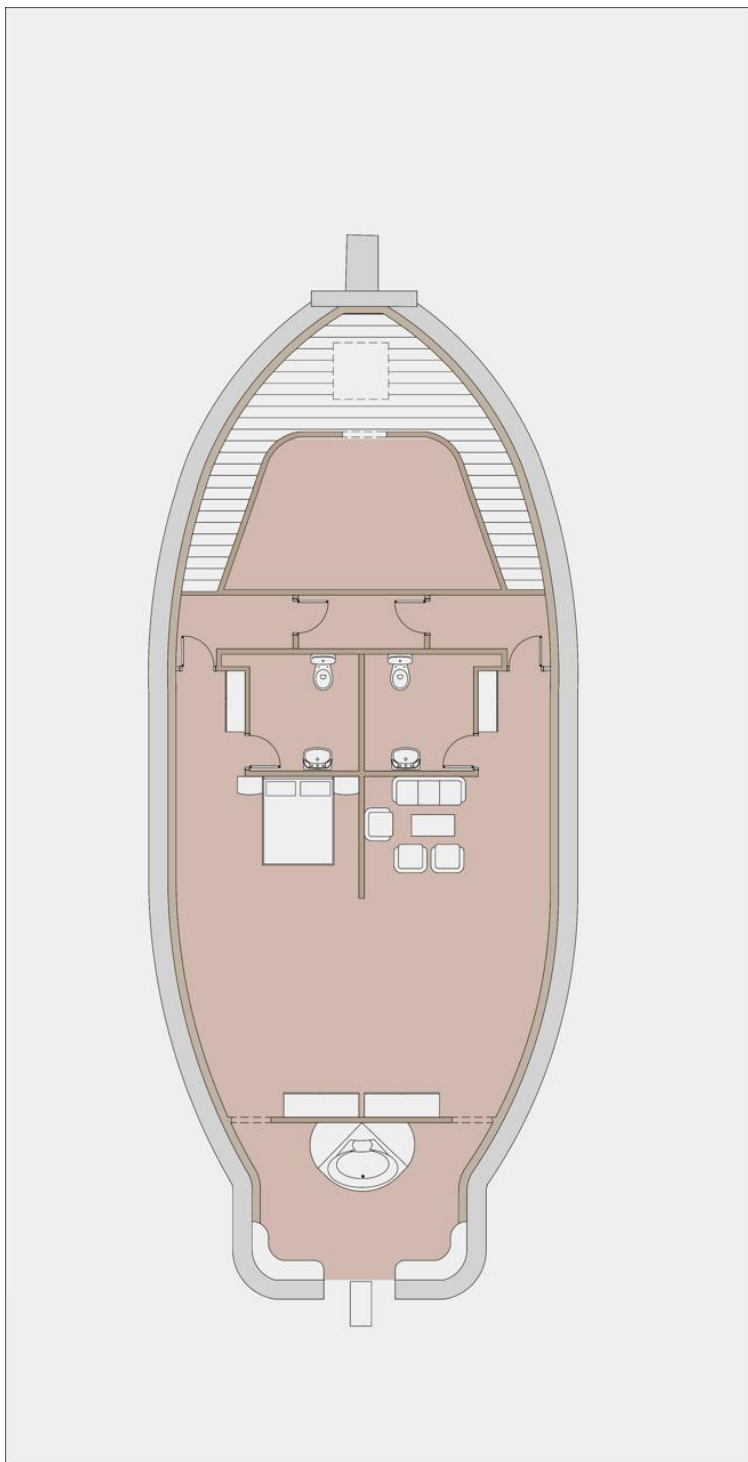
2 EN-SUITE BATHROOMS

Conversions are carried out by the crew in port before boarding. There is no charge for changing configuration between charters.

Suite & Salon



One suite stays made up; the second is struck and reset as a salon - sofa, low tables and reading chairs - for couples travelling alone or families who want the day space instead of the extra bed.

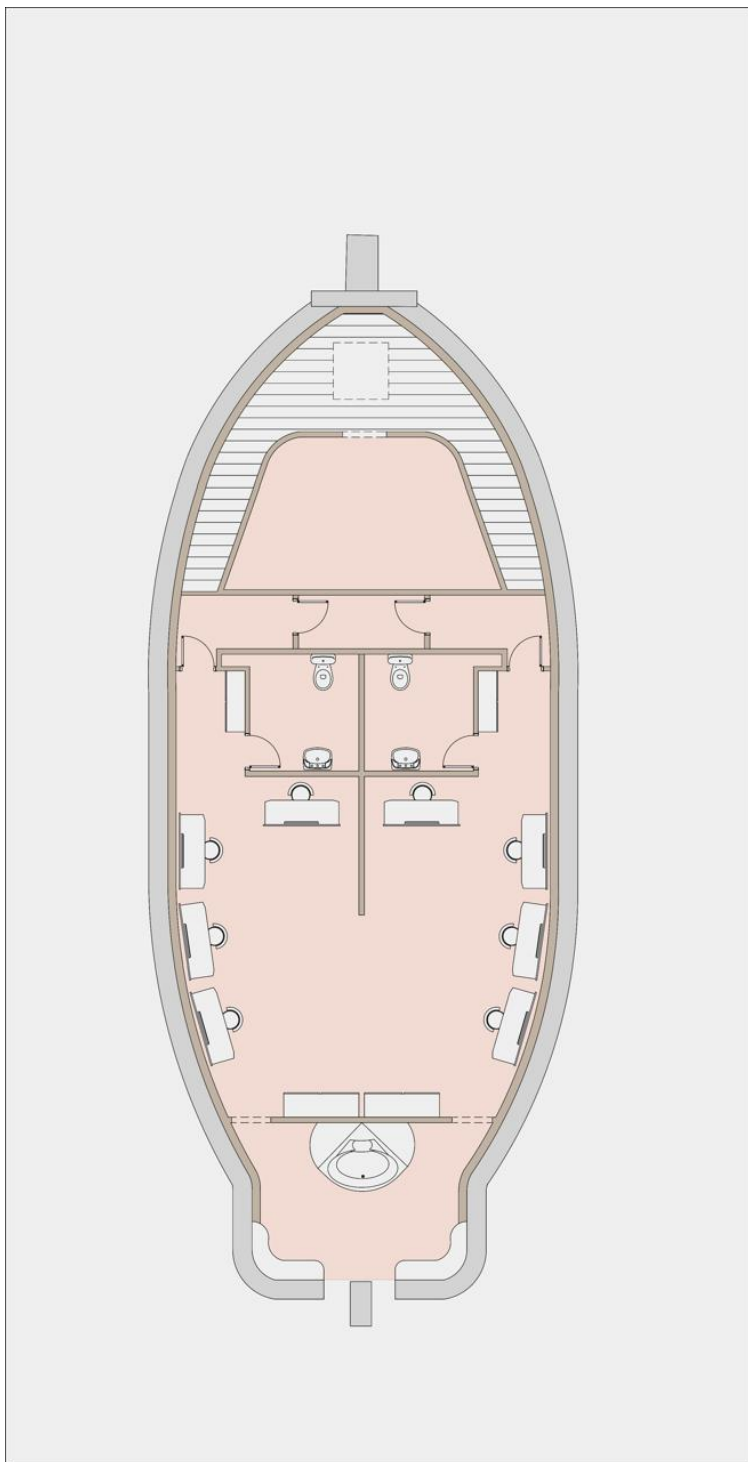
FULL SALON CONVERSION

Conversions are carried out by the crew in port before boarding. There is no charge for changing configuration between charters.

Daybed Gathering



Both beds are removed and the deck is lined with six daybeds along the hull sides, leaving a clear centre. Used for wellness retreats, dive briefings, long-table lunches and group charters.

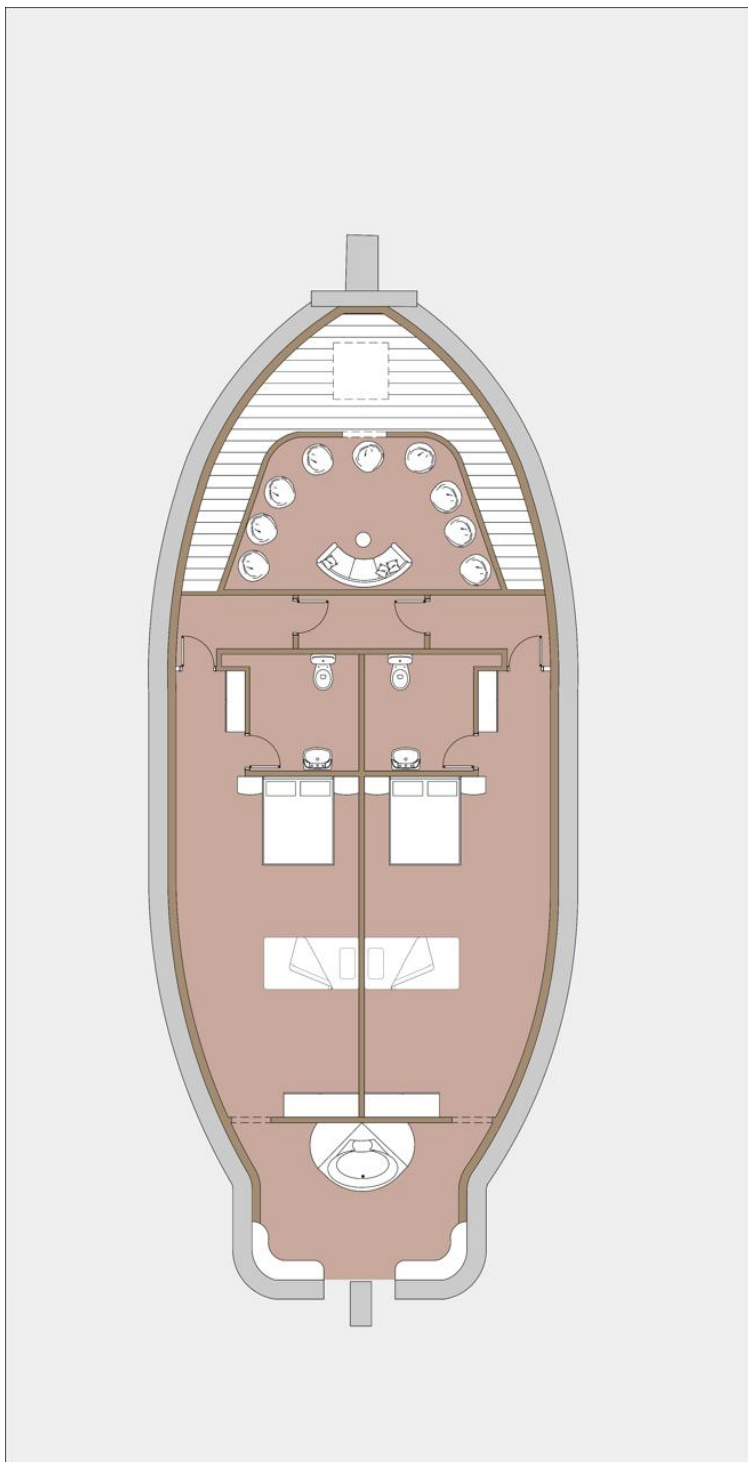

Cinema & Event



Tiered forward seating with a curved bar and a projection wall, suites left intact behind it. The configuration we set for film nights, private briefings, product launches and shoot crews.

Cabins



Two further double cabins below the waterline, each en-suite, sitting forward of the crew mess and galley. Cool, quiet and the most stable berths aboard on a night passage.

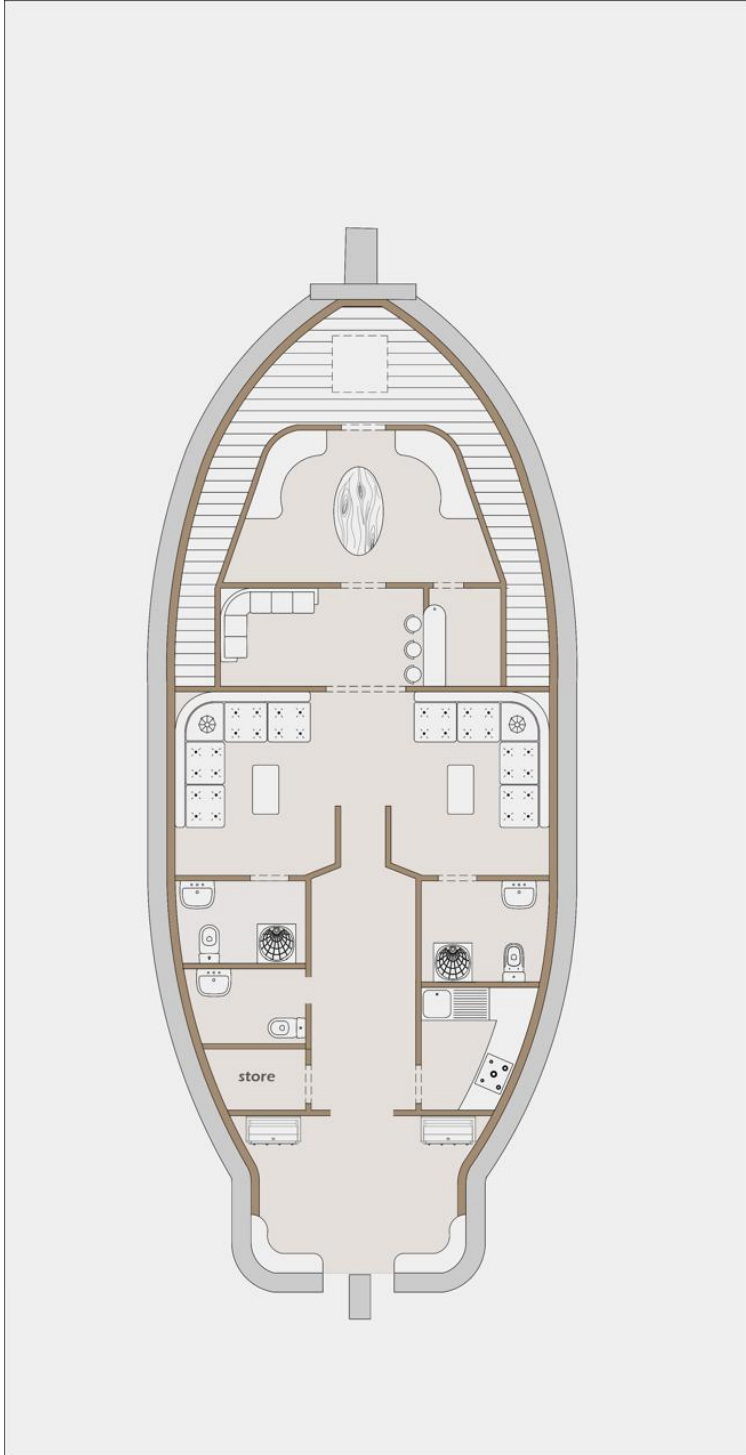

The same footprint with the cabins struck and given over to dive equipment, provisioning and technical stores - the layout we run for expedition, dive and film charters.

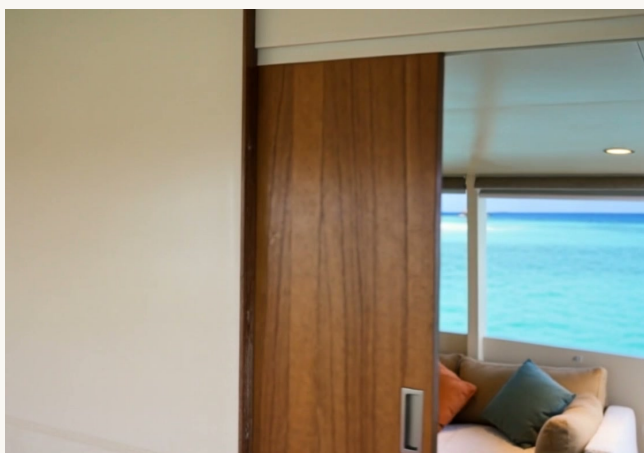
The conversions, continued

Sliding wall opened, joining both rooms into one family suite.



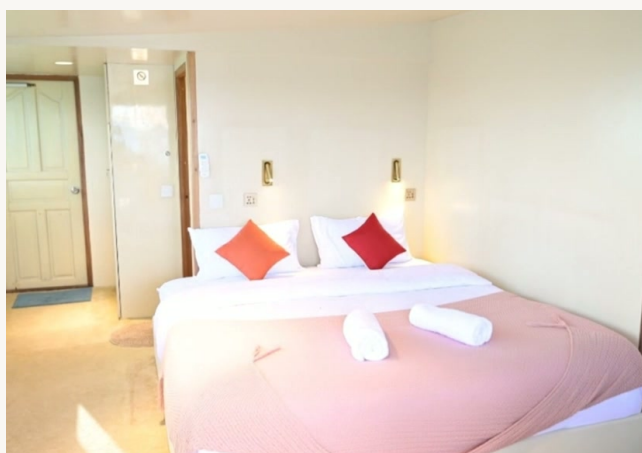
Full-length glazing on both sides of the joined upper deck space.
